Neville UK PLC — Our Statement on the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR)

July 2026

The EU's Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR) becomes generally applicable on 12 August 2026, introducing new EU-wide rules on packaging design, recyclability, recycled content and producer responsibility. We are preparing for this as a natural extension of the standards we already hold ourselves to.

At Nevilles, responsible packaging is part of who we are — reflected in our FSC certification, ISO 14001 environmental management system, and our commitment to the UN Sustainable Development Goals under our ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance) strategy.

What we're doing:

- Reviewing our GenWare range against PPWR requirements to ensure uninterrupted supply into EU and Irish markets
- Auditing food-contact products against new substance restrictions, including PFAS and heavy metals
- Improving packaging recyclability — reducing material use and increasing recycled content where possible
- Registering with relevant EU producer schemes so trading continues without disruption
- We can confirm that we have no single-use plastic catering disposables.

The work outlined above runs alongside existing UK Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) obligations, so customers can rely on us to meet the right standards wherever they trade.

Nevilles will keep customers updated as PPWR's requirements are phased in between now and 2030. Any product packing changes will be reflected in our brochures and data sheets in due course.
